CC level of care being looked at	Does not align with the national education standards. Report should be available in May.		
Collaborative protocols	All areas of NYS with the exception of NYC and Long Island will operate under the same ALS protocols. Education is being developed and everyone should be on line by 6/1.		
BLS protocols	Will be evaluated and revised over the next year. Especially looking at Stroke protocol.		
Check & inject	Demonstration project due to the high cost of Epipens. Special syringes used and amps of epi. 580 BLS agencies have participated and about 19,000 BLS providers trained. Has been submitted for adoption to the Commissioner of Health.		
Paramedic/CC squads	Must carry narcotics. If have not submitted an application by 2/1 must drop back in level of care.		
EMSC	Anne Ryan is the process of being vetted to be out representative.		
Semac/Semscos recommendation	Have Commissioner of Health and Commissioner of Education meet and revise nursing practice to allow administration of Propofol, Ketamine and Etomidate.	Referred to Government affairs for consideration
