AI a Friend or Foe? What would happen if we could predict admissions from triage?

Emergency department overcrowding and boarding have become a national crisis, affecting everything from patient outcomes to financial performance. Industries like airlines and hotels use bookings to forecast demand and plan. In the ED, we don't have reservations. Could you imagine airlines and hotels without reservations, solely forecasting and planning from historical trends? Welcome to health care.

What if we developed a tool to forecast admissions needs before an order is placed? That could fundamentally improve how hospitals manage patient flow, leading to better outcomes.
