Poster Abstract Categories

- Research Posters should include information about the process and results of a study aimed at generating new knowledge relative to a specific research question to advance clinical practice.
- Evidence-based practice Posters should include information about the process and results of identifying and implementing evidence guiding practice change that is aimed at advancing clinical practice.

Poster Presentation Guidelines

- Poster presentations will be most effective if they are organized into clearly defined sections such as title, author, author affiliation, abstract, background, methodology, data, results, conclusion, and references.
- Design graphs, charts, and tables to show results. Avoid presenting too many variables on a single graph or chart.
- A scavenger hunt type game is being developed based on the information presented in your posters. A prize will be awarded for those conference attendees who can answer questions presented on your work.
